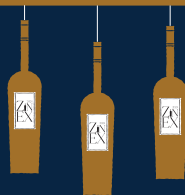

Armed with these new insights, DawnMarie launched the expansion of her business service offerings to include a higher level of consulting that has helped take her clients' fundraising efforts to new heights.

A natural at connecting with audiences, DawnMarie discovered another true love—serving as Master of Ceremonies in both live-event and virtual spaces. Highlights include emceeding large-scale national conferences for 9,000 critical care nurses—whom she considers true heroes.

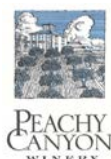

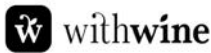
